President's Fees

Executive summary and recommendations

Introduction

At its meeting on 7 February 2007, the Finance and Resources Committee recommended to the Council that:

- (1) the President should receive an additional daily fee of £300 per day for up to 30 days per year (i.e. a maximum of £9,000 per year), for work such as appraisals of Council members and the Chief Executive, meetings with governments and other stakeholders, the Partners conference, planning the Council Awayday and presentations and other speaking engagements.
- (2) payment should be backdated to the appointment of the current President on 9 July 2006; and
- (3) that the arrangements should be reviewed in six months' time (i.e. August 2007)

These recommendations were ratified by the Council at its meeting on 29 March 2007.

In the light of the decision to review the arrangement after six months, the arrangement was being brought back to the Finance and Resources Committee at its meeting on 18 September 2007.

The Committee agreed to recommend to Council that the arrangement should continue.

The Council is requested to ratify the decision of the Finance and Resources Committee.
