The Visitors' report is only a recommendation and the Panel may depart from the Visitors' recommendation where it is satisfied that it is appropriate to do so.

The Panel must reach its own decision and give reasons for that decision.

Decision:

Following an annual monitoring audit, an approval visit is required to determine how the programme continues to meet the standards of education and training. The approval visit should be undertaken along a 4-5 month time scale.

Reasons

The panel agreed that a visit was required to review the issues raised in the annual monitoring visitors' report.
