**HEALTH PROFESSIONS COUNCIL
INCOME TAX RELIEF IN RESPECT OF ANNUAL FEES AND
SUBSCRIPTIONS**

Thank you for your letter of the 24th October the contents of which have been noted. In view of the fact that the Health Professions Council has succeeded the Council for Professions Supplementary to Medicine it has been decided that the approval granted to the CPSM should continue as if there has merely been a change of title.

The affect of this will be that List 3 will be amended shortly to include the title of the Health Professions Council. A note to explain that the HPC succeeded the CPSM from the 1st April 2002 will be included. The entry for the Council for Professions Supplementary to Medicine will be amended to explain that this no longer exists and that the HPC succeed it with effect from the 1st April 2002.

Please advise your members to quote both titles for the time being when making a claim to tax relief through their local tax office.
