

BULLET POINTS FOR INTERIM ORDERS

- **All parties will introduce themselves**
- **The Solicitor for the HPC will present the case**
- **The registrant will then present their case.**
- **The decision for the panel is whether the allegation is of such a serious nature that the following grounds need to be satisfied**
 - **Protection of members of the public**
 - **Otherwise in the public interest**
 - **In the interests of the person concerned**
- **The panel can either impose an interim suspension order or an interim conditions of practice order**
- **When consider whether an interim conditions of practice order the panel should not impose conditions which are of a final disposal nature, but have in mind what type of conditions can satisfy the above grounds**
- **The order can be imposed for a maximum period of 18 months – and if the case hasn't been disposed of at a final hearing will need to reviewed at 6 months and then at 3 monthly intervals thereafter.**
- **Use the legal assessor to assist you in the drafting**
